At Casa De Vida our prices vary on a variety of situations.

We do an assessment of your loved one and go from there. The minimum pricing would start at \$3,400.00 per month for a shared room and go up from there depending on the needs of the resident.

Some factors that would raise the price are - but not limited to:

- Are they ambulatory or in a wheelchair?
- How many times a day do they need medicine administered?
- Are they continent for both bladder and bowel?
- Are there dietary restrictions?
- Are they cooperative and willing to help with their care?
- Are they bedridden or on Hospice?

These are the main things we look at while assessing your loved one, and we understand cost is a factor. Most families think a private room is best, however, we encourage shared rooms for not only the cost, but the socialization can be healthy. Honestly, our residents are only in their rooms a short time during the day and we do pair up residents that are suitable with one another.

The price range would be between \$3,400 and \$4,000 for a non-hospice resident in most cases.

Our Hospice prices start at \$4,000 per month in a shared room and should not exceed \$5,000.00 per month under most ordinary circumstances.

There are extra charges for Depends and Wipes if we supply them, we encourage our families to purchase them at Costco, Walmart or Sam's Club by the case for the best deal!

We do have someone that comes to the home for pedicures and the cost for that is \$25.00.
