CHOOSE WELL WORKSHOP Using Technology to Help Locate Distinguished Assisted Living Communities

On October 27th, Choose Well had a workshop that provided a step-by-step tutorial on how RCFE owners and staff can use the new Choose Well mobile app for both Android and iOS. The workshop was the first to take place in-person since the pandemic and was held at the Lions Clubhouse in North Park. Attendees were treated to a lunch served by El Comal while they learned how to update their facility profiles and navigate through the Choose Well app.

How to Update Your Choose Well Profile Page

To update your Choose Well profile page:

- 1. Send an email to <u>info@choosewellsandiego.org</u> with your facility name.
- 2. You will receive a personalized link for your facility. When you click that link, there will be a form with all the fields you wish to update.
- 3. Fill out the form, and click "Submit Updates" at the bottom.
- 4. Choose Well staff will review the updates and apply them to your profile within 2 business days.

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Music Therapy Event: "Life is A Song"

On October 20, 2021, Choose Well participated in the "Life is a Song" music therapy event hosted by the South County Action Network (SoCAN). Music therapy professionals led older adults in a lively and engaging hour of song and dance. Participants sang along to songs such as "Celebrate Good Times, Come On" and "Quizás, Quizás, Quizás." Attendees were even given maracas, drums and other instruments to play as they were encouraged to get up and dance with the music.

Many organizations sponsored the event, including "Golden Mic" sponsors, Sarsis Health & Tech Solutions and St. Paul's Senior Services. In total, there were 21 vendors present, which included Sharp HospiceCare, City of Chula Vista, The Salvation Army, Scripps, and the County of San Diego. These vendors shared information on services for older adults, provided free lunch, and even donated opportunity drawing prizes. Choose Well held a booth to promote the program to many people who stopped by. One attendee suggested a great feature to add to the facility profile of Choose Well Members would be the kinds of food options an RCFE offers, such as vegan or organic meals. Thank you for the great idea! This is why we are so happy to have in-person events back in action, so we are able to have meaningful conversations with Choose Well Members and potential consumers who have great ideas to continuously improve the program.
